IX. Principal's Report - Mr. Ramon Moss

- A. Good evening everyone, thank you for being here, we have thirty some parents here.
- B. Monday is a holiday for Presidents Day for students.
- C. Next Friday February 24th is the end of cycle #4. A week from then is report cards.
- D. Let me thank the PTO for everything you do to support students, faculty, staff and administration. We really appreciate all your participation.
- E. Another piece of great news, the organization Children at Risk did it's annual ranking of best schools, and Carnegie is number one in the high schools. There was a press release on Monday morning. It is cause for celebration.
- F. On Tuesday we had our Valentine's pep rally. There prize is having Monday off. We want to celebrate at least with a pizza party. Our secretary is reaching out to vendors. We're very proud.
- G. I wanted to mention a little bit about the budget. That applies to our current school year. Last year at this time principals were asked to make an estimate for enrollment. That is the snapshot date. We were 19 students over my predication. So in January, last month, we received additional funding, ~\$43,000. So we are meeting extra needs from teachers now. One of the big ticket items is the irrigation system. There are three components of the building, the perimeter where a lot of the plants have died due to the broken irrigation. We want to fix that before we get new plants. There is also the athletic fields and then the green roof. There is a class, Wildlife for short, that work on components of the school. Irrigation is going to be a critical factor. I have gotten some good feedback on vendors.
- H. Another things is updating our sound system in the gym. For this past Valentine's day dance, we rented a sound system. We would like to have something more permanent.
- In terms of next year, we don't have any solid figures, but central office has notified us that we are running a deficit. This may reduce our PUA. Not only in HISD schools but central administration. We may have a 5% decrease in our general funding. We are trying to put some information together. We are trying to do some things to help, such as increase our enrollment. We won't know that until after Spring Break. We can also try to increase our daily attendance. Our attendance is 97-98%, which is great. This is part of our funding for next year.
- J. Hopefully I appeased everybody with the good news. Next I am going to try and explain Attendance laws, that HISD has misunderstood. Not just Carnegie, but HISD. The state monitors attendance, and with our better understanding of state

laws, Mr. Garner and I are going to provide some more information. If your student received an asterisk * on their report card, it means your student is reaching the limit of excused and unexcused absences. There is a helpful link regarding attendance on the left side of our webpage.
